

RE: SC 20429 *State of Connecticut v. Bruce John Bemer*

We are scheduled to argue the above appeal in person before the Supreme Court next Tuesday at 9:30 a.m. Attorney Killen has just been informed that a member of his family has been diagnosed with COVID-19 and he must therefore be in a mandatory quarantine for two weeks. Attorney Levesque has consulted with his client who has a strong preference for the case being argued in person before the Justices. Live oral arguments are likely to provide a better opportunity for satisfactory communications between counsel and the Justices. The case is a matter of considerable public importance. Attorney Killen has no objection to putting the matter over to the October term but would defer to the Court's preference. Attorney Levesque believes it would be appropriate to postpone oral argument until the October Term so that it may be argued in person.
